ETHRA 2021 Scholarship Information

- **The \$1000 scholarship is open to qualifying graduating high school seniors or current college/university students living or attending school in the East Texas area or any active ETHRA member pursuing a degree in Human Resources, Business, or related field of study**

Eligibility: High School Senior (Graduating 2021) or currently enrolled college/university student. Student must live or attend school in East Texas.

Proof of enrollment, minimum 6 hours for Fall 2021 is required. Payment of the scholarship will be made to the student's account at the college/university in the fall of 2021 after proof of current enrollment is available.

Minimum of 3.0/4.0 GPA



Please submit the following information:

1. **Completed Application Form:** Please completely answer all questions.
2. **Academic Transcript:** A copy of your academic transcripts from high school and all colleges or universities you have attended is required. (IMPORTANT: TRANSCRIPT MUST INCLUDE SPRING SEMESTER 2021) Unofficial transcripts may be submitted as long as they are legible, have not been modified, and show a clear label of the credit-granting institution. If you do not have these available, you must contact the school(s) and request the information.
3. **Letters of Recommendation:** Two letters of recommendation should be solicited from individuals other than immediate family. This may include friends, employers, or educators who can speak to your ability to complete an undergraduate degree program and/or who know of your educational history, abilities, motivation and potential for success.
4. **Personal Statement Essay:** (400 words or less) Describe your educational goals and objectives and who or what has been the strongest influence in your life.
5. **Short Answer Question:** (100 words or less) What would receiving this scholarship mean to you? Do you have any special need (financial or other) that should be considered?
